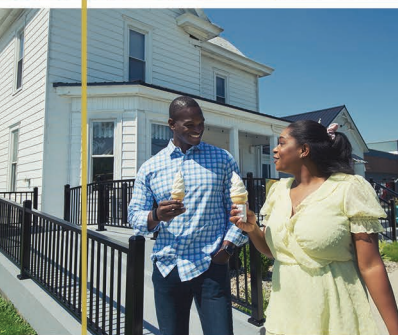

Explore Underground Worlds

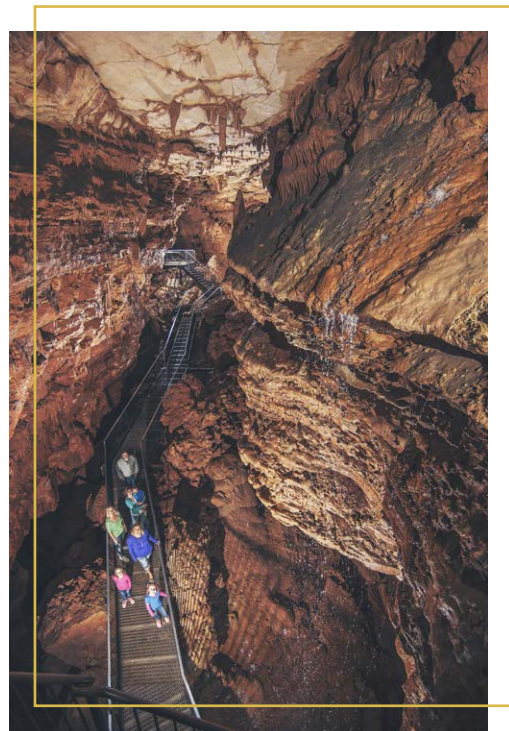

Indiana Caverns Family Adventure Park

Take in the thrills, chills, and everything in between at one of our most popular destinations. Whether it's the 35-foot underground waterfall or the escape room, there's plenty here to take your breath away and keep your whole family entertained.

Fun things to see and do:

- Enjoy a 25 minute boat ride on an underground river
- See evidence of the Ice Age from 40,000 years ago in the Big Bone Mountain room
- Glide through the air on the Bat Chaser aerial coaster
- Test your wits against two escape rooms
- **Go Deeper:** Descend 200 feet to kayak an underground river in this four hour tour

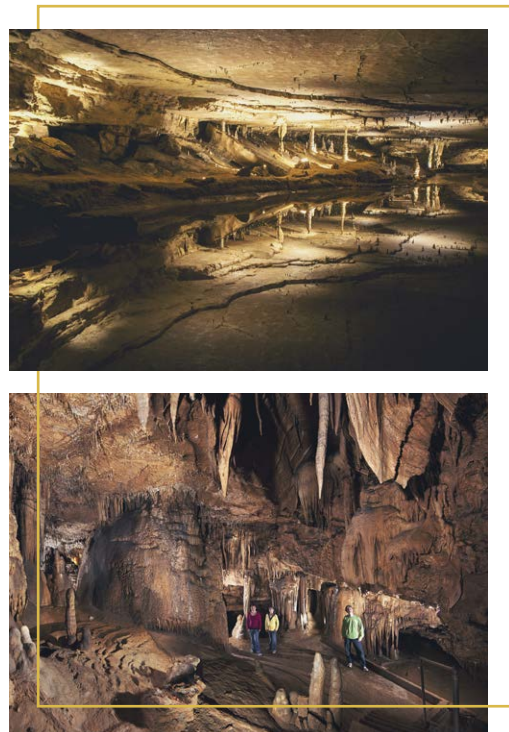


Marengo Cave

Discovered by two children in 1883, this cave is a U.S. National Landmark that is hailed as "the most profusely decorated cavern." With cabins, tents, and RV camp space available, you can have a smores-filled night over a fire pit while modern conveniences of in-ground electricity and a bath house are right there when you want them.

Fun things to see and do:

- Take the Crystal Palace or Dripstone Trail tours for two difference experiences
- Race through the woods on our pedal carts, with a separate track for little ones, too
- Navigate an 8,000 sq. foot Miner's Mega Maze with a lookout tower in the middle for help
- **Go Deeper:** Choose from five trips to rarely seen parts of the cave



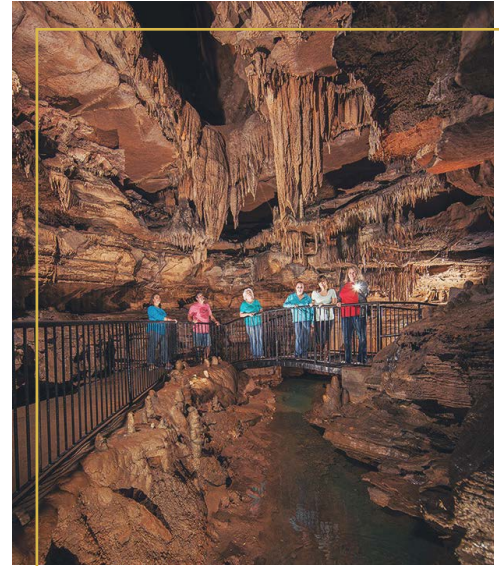
Explore Underground Worlds

Squire Boone Caverns

Found in 1790 by Squire Boone and his brother, the famous frontiersman Daniel Boone, this attraction boasts a working gristmill that's powered by a stream that flows from within the caverns.

Fun things to see and do:

- *Candle and soap making demonstrations, plus homemade rock candy and fudge*
- *See the Rock of Ages, a 40-foot-tall formation estimated to be over 1 million years old*
- *Fly through the forest canopy at our Zipline Adventures with more than 10,000 feet of line*

Indiana Cave Trail

Complete the Indiana Cave Trail by visiting Indiana Caverns, Marengo Cave, Squire Boone Cave, and Bluespring Caverns (located a little north of Harrison County) for four unique cave experiences. Receive a free t-shirt (and bragging rights) when you complete the trail!

A Perfect Day in Historic Downtown Corydon

With plenty of historic buildings and landmarks to see, your family can experience a bit of the past in new and exciting ways. The Harrison County Discovery Center is a great place for kids to use modern technology to connect with history, while parents can explore small town shops and boutiques. Then, bring the whole family together for a delicious meal at one of our local restaurants and top it off with homemade candy.

Harrison County Discovery Center

Learn about southern Indiana's wildlife, caves, and history at this high-tech museum. There are plenty of fun, interactive displays, including our 360-degree video projection of the Battle of Corydon, the only Civil War battle fought in the state.



Corydon Capitol State Historic Site

Take a tour through Indiana's first State Capitol Building and Governor's Headquarters, getting an in-depth look at how the state first began.



Zimmerman Art Glass

In its fifth generation of operation, see how the Zimmerman family has perfected their technique over the years as they make beautiful objects before your eyes in ongoing demonstrations.



White House Candy

Stop in for a treat (or many!) as this shop offers an extensive selection of homemade flavored popcorns, chocolates, old-fashioned candies, and ice cream.



A Perfect Day in Historic Downtown Corydon

Butt Drugs

A permanent fixture in Corydon since 1952, this local landmark has a classic soda fountain where you can get your favorite ice cream, classic sodas, and a delicious shake or malt. And don't miss the chance to purchase a souvenir at their "buttique!"



The Kintner House Inn

Located in the heart of Historic Corydon, this inn was built in 1873 and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. With a variety of sights, stores, and activities all within walking distance, this is a perfect place to start your adventure.



Fan Favorites for Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Frederick's Café

Frederick's Café serves up all the classic diner favorites like pancakes, biscuits, eggs, and bacon.

Beaver Street Brick Oven and Grill

Beaver Street Brick Oven and Grill creates delicious brick oven fired pizzas, special local favorites, and brews their own beer on site.

1816 Modern Kitchen

Named for the year Indiana became a state, visit for a contemporary twist on comfort food classics alongside craft cocktails.

Family Fun Goes From Sunup To Sundown

With so many things to see and do, it's a good idea to plan ahead for your next trip to Harrison County.

O'Bannon Woods State Park

Nestled along the Ohio River, you can trek through 18 miles of day-use trails in the gorgeous scenery of Southern Indiana, or go the distance on the 25.5 mile Adventure Trail, a three-day hike with five shelters for overnight stays.

Fun things to see and do:

- Go mountain biking or horseback riding for a different view of the trails
- Enjoy the Family Aquatic Center for exciting water slides and fun activities for all ages
- Bring a canoe to paddle down the 11 miles of the Blue River
- Explore Wyandotte Cave to see how Native Americans mined flint as far back as 8,000 BC
- Visit the Nature Center for cultural displays, live snakes and turtles, bird viewing, and living history demonstrations including a one-of-a-kind 1850's hay press

Cave County Canoes

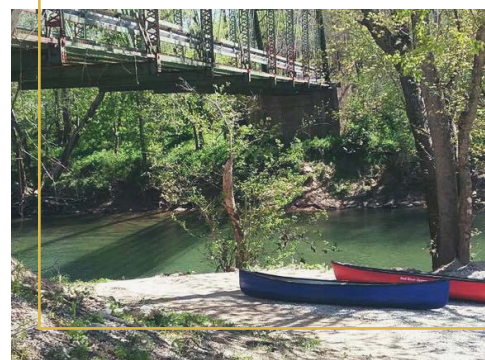

Located on the beautiful Blue River, it's fairly likely you'll run across some of the local wildlife such as deer, otters, beavers, wild turkeys, and blue herons in their scenic natural environment.

Fun things to see and do:

- Kayak or canoe for a half day (great for families with children ages 3+), full day, or even a 2 day trip with an available campground along on the river
- Paddle through forests, rapids, under bridges, and alongside pebbled beaches which are a perfect spot to stop for lunch
- In Milltown, stop by Blue River Landing, a restaurant with ample outdoor dining, sandwiches, sides, and ice cream (open seasonally on weekends)

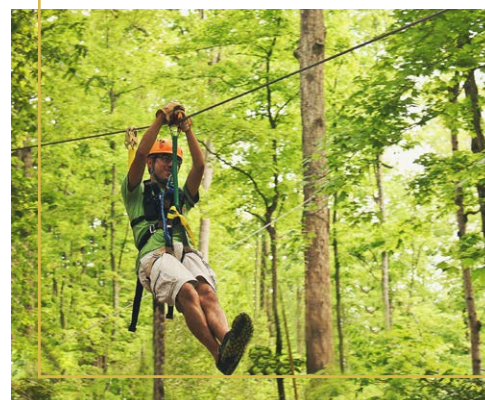
* All rentals include transportation to and from the river, a map, lifejackets, and oars.
